The Urgent Need for Cancer Care Investments

A REGION IN NEED, A FUTURE WITHIN REACH

Southwest Virginia faces a critical challenge in cancer care. Economic and distance-related barriers, along with gaps in early detection, mean too many patients receive late-stage diagnoses, leading to more complex treatments, increased mortality and unnecessary suffering.

CARILION CLINIC TREATS MORE THAN 3,200 NEW CANCER PATIENTS YEARLY, AND THE NUMBERS TELL A COMPELLING STORY

National cancer cases continue to rise, particularly among older populations. Combined with an aging population in our region, this increase naturally means the volume of critical treatments and procedures is going up as well, and yet our current cancer center, built in 1980, operates beyond capacity, struggling to keep pace with the growing demand.

Today, many patients across Southwest Virginia and bordering states face significant barriers to accessing cancer care technology and services that require space and resources that our current facility cannot accommodate.

A father diagnosed with cancer might need weeks of daily radiation, yet he must choose between traveling hours for treatment or keeping his job to support his family. A grandmother with a treatable tumor may delay care due to limited access to specialists, only to find that by the time she receives treatment, her options have drastically narrowed. A child battling leukemia may need to leave the community entirely, forcing their family to separate for months to receive care elsewhere.

THESE ARE CHOICES NO ONE SHOULD HAVE TO MAKE

Our region already has a foundation of strong, dedicated cancer care. We must grow our facilities, technologies and services to continue meeting the needs of patients in our region. Survival trends are in our favor thanks to increased access and timely medical care. Since 1991, the national cancer death rate has declined 33% as more research-based treatments become available, cancer diagnoses occur earlier and tobacco use continues to drop.

Carilion is Southwest Virginia's only academic medical center providing highly specialized and advanced medical treatment for complex conditions, drawing patients from a 250-mile radius. Our specialists, surgeons and researchers are nationally recognized, and our research collaborations with leading academic and regional partners are driving innovation in cancer treatment. We must build on our strengths to meet rising demand and provide seamless, compassionate care and access to the state-of-the-art treatment our patients deserve.



A Once-in-a-Generation Opportunity

While these challenges are real, so is the opportunity to address them. Carilion Clinic and Blue Ridge Cancer Care have served cancer patients together for more than 40 years but are physically constrained and need more room to grow alongside the needs of our region. At the same time, the landscape around us is changing.


We stand on the edge of true transformation, with the chance to build a next-generation cancer center that will:

The Carilion Taubman Cancer Center will create an economic ripple effect, generating new jobs, fostering further collaboration with research institutions and strengthening the healthcare infrastructure across our region by attracting biotech firms, medical researchers and healthcare innovators. The Vision

EXPANDED ACCESS AND CAPACITY

- Growing from 40,000 to 250,000 square feet
- Doubling patient capacity from 3,500 to 7,000 people annually
- Reducing wait times and increasing appointment availability

ADVANCED TREATMENT OPTIONS

- Precision medicine and molecular diagnostics for targeted therapies
- Expanded radiation therapy, which is currently available in Northern Virginia and Hampton Roads, leaving a critical service gap for patients in our service region
- Increased access to clinical trials, bringing innovative treatments to our patients years before they become widely available

A NEW MODEL FOR COMPREHENSIVE CARE

- Multidisciplinary approach where patients meet with their entire care team in a single day
- Dedicated spaces for nutrition, psychological support and palliative care, ensuring patients and families receive whole-person support
- A dedicated pediatric oncology unit, quadrupled in size, focused on our youngest patients, reducing the need for families to travel out of state for childhood cancer care
